Her role is to guide patients, families and caregivers through their time with Upland Hills Hospice and through the end of a life. Barb explains, "I'll meet with you and your family. Together, we'll determine what you need and I'll connect you to people within our community who will help and support you. I am also here to provide support in any way I can. I offer help with the physical, financial and emotional challenges that may accompany the end of life."

As a hospice social worker, Barb helps patients and caregivers understand the role of hospice and the services available to them. She is also a wife and mother. She lives nearby and serves as a volunteer EMT within her community. Barb has over 6 years of social work experience and is currently working on a Master's Degree in Social Work.
