Eligibility Requirements and Conditions

- Any undergraduate or graduate college student currently enrolled in a “healthcare degree” program may apply
 - This includes, but is not limited to, degree programs and coursework supporting the following professions: Athletic Trainer, Cardiac Sonographer, Cardiovascular Technologist, Dental Assistant, Dentist, Diagnostic Medical Sonographer, Electrocardiographic Technician, Emergency Medical Technician, Exercise Scientist/Specialist, Mammographer, Medical Assistant, Nuclear Medicine Technologist, Nurse Anesthetists, Nurse Assistant, Nurse Practitioner, Nursing Assistant, Paramedic, Pharmacist, Phlebotomist, Physical Therapist, Physician Assistant, Physician, Practical Nurse, Registered Nurse, Respiratory Therapist
 - Pre-professional programs such as pre-nursing and pre-medicine students are qualified as well. Students begin their coursework but ultimately transfer to another institution to complete their degree.
- Employees and Pacific Medical Training, and their family members, are not eligible to participate in this program.
- All entries become the sole property of Pacific Medical Training.
- Proof of enrollment in a qualifying degree program may be required for eligibility.

Madison Area Builders Association Scholarship Application

For Careers in the Building and Construction Industry

The Madison Area Builders Association has established a scholarship program. Each year, the Association will award scholarships to students pursuing post high school education. Preferences for scholarships will be given to students pursuing construction-related education, and students who are family members of or employed by members of the Madison Area Builders Association. The scholarship may be used to fund college, technical or vocational school, public or private post-secondary institutions. Scholarships will be paid directly to the school of choice of the winners to help defray the cost of tuition.

The Scholarship is an up to \$2,000 grant paid directly to the post-secondary educational institution.

Distribution:

Scholarship recipients are required to submit proof of enrollment to the Association. The scholarship award must be used in the current academic year. Scholarship recipients may be required to submit a copy of their tuition expense report.

Deadline:

Applicant is responsible to ensure all application materials and requirements are submitted to the Madison Area Builders Association by **September 30th annually**.

Scholarship Application

Objective Criteria Used to Select Recipients of Scholarship and Rules for Eligibility.

1. A transcript of grades must be submitted with each application.
2. Recipient must be enrolled or planned to be enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution.
3. The recipient's major field of study must be directly related to the construction industry, as determined by the Madison Area Builders Association Workforce Committee.
4. Scholarship awards will be evaluated and determined by majority vote of the Madison Area Builders Association Workforce Committee.
5. Applicants must be Wisconsin residents located in one of five counties (Dane, Iowa, Columbia or Marquette) or planning to relocate.
6. At least one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, prior employer, colleague, etc. (Non-family)

Procedures to Supervise Use of Scholarship Funds

1. The Workforce Committee will review the information required to be submitted by each recipient annually and for each academic term, as previously described.
2. Scholarships will be paid directly to the educational institution. An agreement between the institution and the Association will require the educational institution to use the funds received from the Association exclusively for tuition and fees of the named recipient, unless otherwise approved.
3. Each recipient must submit, in advance of receipt of any funds, invoices from an educational institution for tuition, for courses that meet the other requirements of the Association.
4. The Association will aggressively seek refund of any scholarship funds, which are not used exclusively for tuition, books or supplies by a qualified recipient enrolled in a qualified field of study. Such effort may include withholding all future disbursements, disqualification for future scholarships and appropriate legal action.

With that being said, we must note that only eligible applicants may participate.



Eligibility Requirements

At this moment, our eligibility criteria are as follows:

- Applicants must be U.S. citizens. International exchange students may not participate. While their input would be appreciated, they are not eligible unless they are U.S. citizens residing in the United States.
- Applicants must possess a high school diploma, High School Equivalency Diploma or similarly titled credential or anticipate completion of such. Failure to obtain such a credential before this scholarship program concludes is ground for unconditional disqualification. Should a participant disqualified in such a manner take a winning place, it will be given to the runner-up.
- Applicants must be current high school students, home-schooled students, or college students attending a high school or accredited post-secondary institution in the United States provided they attend any.

Applicants not in education are not eligible. Applicants attending schools or post-secondary institutions outside the United States do not qualify.

- Applicants must be planning to pursue a degree at an accredited U.S. post-secondary institution or already in pursuit of such a degree. The winner's failure to pursue a degree on those conditions after this scholarship program concludes shall result in the revocation of the monetary award.
- Applicants must have a minimum 3.00 GPA at the time this scholarship program concludes.

How to Apply



To request the Car Seat Research Scholarship, we suggest that you fill out the application form. Additionally, we require that you include an official high school or college transcript.

Should you choose to omit filling out any field, the application form will fail to go through. Please make sure to answer the Automated Public Turing Test question in a manner that would allow us to conclude that the form has been filled out by a human being.

After you have completed the form, you must include a 2000-3000 word essay. The essay must respond to any of the three essay topics we provide below. Alternatively, you may create a short video (between 5 and 10 minutes) that responds to the same topics. Do note that an essay is not required in that case, and neither is a video if you choose to write an essay.

Your work must be interesting, innovative, and informative. If you choose to make a video, it should also be entertaining. Videos with subtitles are preferable. The essay must be written in plain text and submitted via the application form. Do not use emoticons.

The video must be uploaded to YouTube. Use the application form to submit the link to the video. Do note that by doing so you explicitly agree to allow Car Seat Research to use your video should you become a winner. It may be posted on Car Seat Research for promotional purposes. However, that does not guarantee it will be utilized in any manner.
